#### TERMS OF COMPETITION

The International Portuguese Senior Ladies Golf Competition is a Competition runned by Associação Portuguesa de Seniores de Golfe Senhoras (APSGS)

#### Eligibility

All Amateur Ladies who have reached their 50<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before 31 December 2023, members of a recognized Senior Ladies Association, who have their National Federation or Union membership card, with a maximum handicap of 24,0 shall be eligible to participate.

#### Entries

Entry forms have to be submitted to [senh.senioresdegolfe@gmail.com](mailto:senh.senioresdegolfe@gmail.com) by 9 January 2023.

The entry fee of **€235** must be paid to the APSGS by **Bank transfer** to

**IBAN – PT50 0010 0000 4764 2960 0017 9 SWIFT/BIC – BBPIPTPL** before 17<sup>th</sup> January 2023 or

**in cash** at the registration during the Welcome Cocktail Party on **24<sup>th</sup> January 2023 at 18h00** which will take place at the Dom Pedro The Old Course, Vilamoura.

Entries will be limited to 120 players by order of reception. All winning teams/players from previous editions of this competition may participate, regardless of what their handicap might be.

Exceeding entries will be placed on a waiting list.

Any player not willing to participate for any reason must notify the Competition Committee at the Golf Club or APSGS by three days before the competition starts. Otherwise, the competitor will not be able to participate in the next year event.

The starting times will be established by the Competition Committee according to draw on the doubles competitions and on first day of Individual competition and by classification on the last day of competition.

The Competition Committee reserves the right to alter these terms of competition if advisable reasons exist.

R&A Limited rules apply and those established by the Competition Committee.

## **DOUBLES COMPETITION**

**25 January**

### **Format**

18 holes Fourball Better Ball Stroke play in categories

1<sup>st</sup> category – hcps 0 - 12,0

2<sup>nd</sup> category - hcps 12,1 - 24,0

Participants will play from Red tee-boxes

### **Venue**

Dom Pedro Victoria Golf Course

### **Carts**

Participants are allowed to ride motorized carts.

### **Prizes**

1<sup>st</sup> Gross score in categories

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Net scores, 85% handicap allowance, in categories

Gross scores prevail over handicap scores and all prizes are not cumulative with exception of the Longest drives and Closest to the Pin

### **Ties**

In a event of a tie it will be resolved using the score over the last 9,6,3 and last hole; if still a tie, it will be decided by lot.

## **SINGLES COMPETITION**

**26-27 January**

### **Format**

36 holes

Players from 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> categories - **stroke play**

Players from 4<sup>th</sup> category – **stableford**

Players will play from Red tee-boxes

### **Categories**

1<sup>st</sup>: handicaps 6,0 or lower

2<sup>nd</sup>: handicaps from 6,1 to 12,0

3<sup>rd</sup>: handicaps from 12,1 to 18,0

4<sup>th</sup>: handicaps from 18,1 to 24,0

## **Carts**

Only Ladies over 70 years of age are allowed to ride motorized carts, except for medical reasons.

## **Venues**

### **1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Categories**

1<sup>st</sup> round – Dom Pedro Pinhal

2<sup>nd</sup> round – Dom Pedro Old Course

### **3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Categories**

1<sup>st</sup> round – Dom Pedro Old Course

2<sup>nd</sup> round – Dom Pedro Pinhal

## **Prizes**

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Gross scores in categories - the best stroke play score is the winner of the Teresa Symington Trophy.

1<sup>st</sup> Gross score in Super Senior Players (70th birthday on or before 31 December 2023)

1<sup>st</sup> Gross score in APSGS members

1<sup>st</sup> Net score, full handicap, in categories

Gross scores prevails over handicap scores and all prizes are not cumulative

Entry handicap will not change for net scores purposes from 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> day

## **Ties**

In the event of a tie, the winner of the stroke play competition shall be decided by a sudden-death playoff. Any other ties will be resolved using the score over the last 18,9,6,3 and last holes; if still a tie, it will be decided by lot.

The Competition Committee will lay down the order of the holes to play; otherwise, the natural order of the course will prevail.

## **21<sup>TH</sup> NATION TEAM TROPHY**

To be played by national team consisting of three players. Each nation can play with 1 or 2 teams. The nation with the lowest total of the two scratch scores for each day of competition will be the winner.

In the event of a tie the third score of the two days of competition will be added, in case of further tie the third score of the last round will determine the winner. If still a tie, it will be decided by lot.
